

# **Chung Cheng Financial and Economic Law Review Review Guidelines**

1. In order to ensure the quality of Chung Cheng Financial and Economic Law Review, published by the Department of Financial and Economic Law, National Chung Cheng University, all manuscripts submitted shall be reviewed in accordance with the guidelines ascribed herein.
2. The editorial board shall invite qualified external reviewers with appropriate expertise outside National Chung Cheng University to conduct double-blind peer review.
3. To the extent possible, all the footnotes of the manuscripts shall be firstly checked by assistant editors, and the results shall be sent to the reviewers along with the manuscripts.
4. The editorial board will decide a manuscript as 'accepted for publication', 'not suitable for publication', or 'revise before being accepted for publication'.
5. If the manuscripts accepted for publication exceed the page limit of an issue, the editorial board shall, upon its discretion, select manuscripts for publication based on the balance of research fields and/or novelty.

6. If requested, confirmation of publication or acceptance for publication can be issued by the editorial board according to the actual progress upon the completion of the review process.
7. The guidelines herein take effect upon the ratification by the Department's Faculty Meeting.
